## ***Membership Updates***

## ***Cañada's Plans for CCCCO ZTC Acceleration Grants***

- Both proposals (ECE AS-T with a focus on digital literacy; MATH AS-T with a focus on competency- and equity-based grading) were provisionally accepted, although we will be working with Collaboration Cohorts in Spring 2024 to hash out more details.
- Cañada will receive the first \$20,000 of each plans funding to work on this planning and collaboration work.

## ***LibreTexts ADAPT Workshop***

- Great turnout! A total of 18 faculty from various CSUs and Community Colleges, including many from Cañada, joined in the event.
- Dr. Delmar Larsen of UC Davis, the founder and director of LibreTexts, came to teach faculty about the LibreTexts homework and assessment platform, guiding everyone in creating questions, building assignments, and connecting everything to Canvas.
- In Spring 2024, we'll hold more local workshops on how to use ADAPT—stay tuned!

## ***Reminder about Textbook Adoptions and SB 893***

- SB 893, the legislation that allows the District to fund the Free College Initiative, has specific restrictions with respect to how students in the program can purchase their course materials.
  - SB 893 textbook funds are **only** available for materials that can be purchased through the college bookstore.
  - SB 893 covers textbook costs for students who show financial need and/or who are eligible for the non-resident tuition waiver.
- The more courses and sections that are converted to ZTC or LTC, the further these dollars can go!
