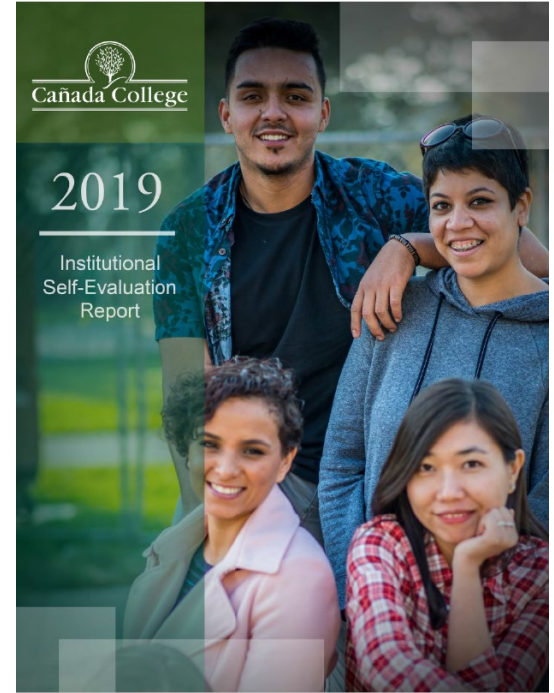

- A written report that we submit to ACCJC
- Provides a narrative and evidence documenting how the college aligns with the newly adopted accreditation Standards
- A required part of a comprehensive review to remain accredited with the Accrediting Commission for Community & Junior Colleges (ACCJC)
