## Accommodation examples

Here are just a few examples of accommodations depending on student Challenges

<p><b>Students who have visual challenges, may require:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All text to be enlarged or have access to a magnifying machine in the classroom or test setting</li> <li>• Textbooks and worksheets to be uploaded to a text-to-voice software</li> <li>• Have text read out loud to them</li> <li>• Text converted into braille</li> <li>• And even have the option to take oral exams instead of written exams</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students with dyslexia may need to have:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A private room so they can read the questions on tests out loud</li> <li>• A reader to read their tests to them</li> <li>• Option to take oral exams</li> <li>• Use of color transparencies to layover text</li> <li>• Exams to be printed on colored paper</li> <li>• Access to text-to-voice software</li> </ul>
<p><b>Students who are undergoing medical treatment for life-threatening illnesses, may require:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Flexible attendance, in case they are ever hospitalized during the semester</li> <li>• Extra time on exams due to medication causing slow processing</li> <li>• Extra time on outside class assignments, in case they are ever hospitalized during the semester</li> </ul>	<p><b>Students with auditory deficits, may require:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Class lectures to be transcribed so they can read them at a later time</li> <li>• A copy of notes and/or a copy of the professor's lecture notes</li> <li>• Closed captions on videos</li> <li>• All oral directions to also be offered in writing</li> </ul>
