How to Check out Technology in 5 Easy Steps

NEED A MOBILE HOTSPOT, GOOGLE CHROMEBOOK, OR GRAPHING CALCULATOR? CAÑADA COLLEGE LIBRARY CAN HELP!

1. Come to the library circulation desk to request technology.
2. Present a valid photo ID (student ID, driver license, state ID, passport).
3. Your enrollment will be verified and you will be directed to complete an online [Cañada College Library Technology Loan Agreement Form](#).
4. Technology items will be checked out to you for 3 months at a time.
5. After 3 months, you can renew the technology by bringing it to the library front desk to be checked for maintenance.
