Cañada College in 3 to 4 years

November 2009

Cañada College is known for academic excellence in transfer, workforce training with ESL and Basic Skills integrated into student educational goals.

Incoming students are placed into courses that prepare them to be successful in college level work. Possibly use a prerequisite system to help direct students into correct courses. Possibly begin with reading prerequisite.

Incoming students encouraged to go into learning communities where college skills and academic skills are integrated into the subjects covered

Active well developed University Center where Cañada graduates have priority registration to CSUs and UCs as well as a growing scholarship program for these students

Vibrant Middle College on campus

2+2+2 pathways from high school to Cañada to university

Early placement testing in all high schools in service area

Cañada has strong, well defined degree pathways to specific CSUs and UCs

Cañada has at least 2 A. A. programs available online and more courses are available as hybrid and online

TV courses are eliminated or moved to community education

Vibrant non-credit programs to meet community needs (i.e. activity courses, ESL (1 course takers), symphony)

ESL pathways are consolidated and the College has created clear pathways to career, workforce, and transfer programs.

National reputation for our Learning Center, MESA and TRiO programs
