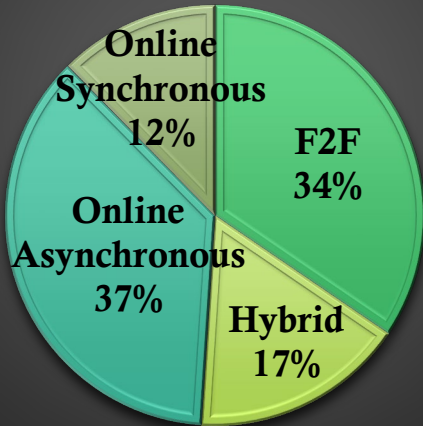

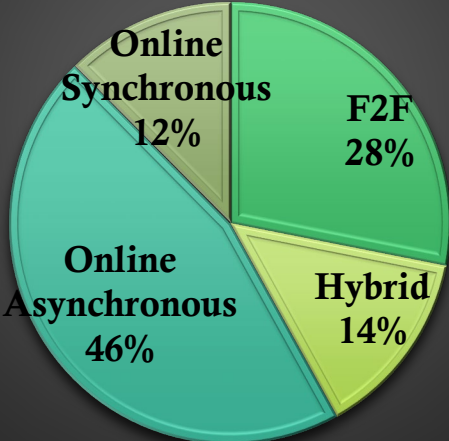

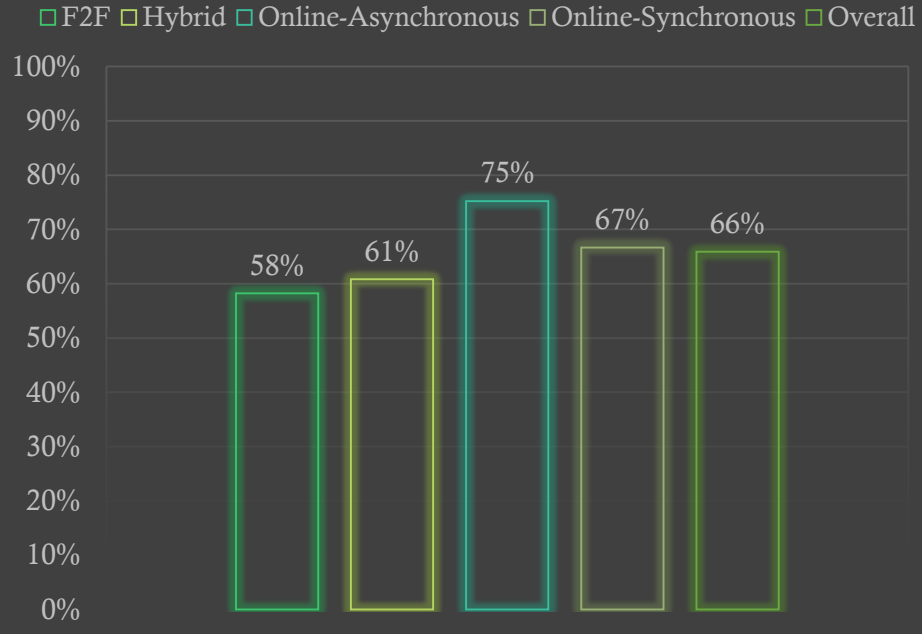

Course Fill Rate

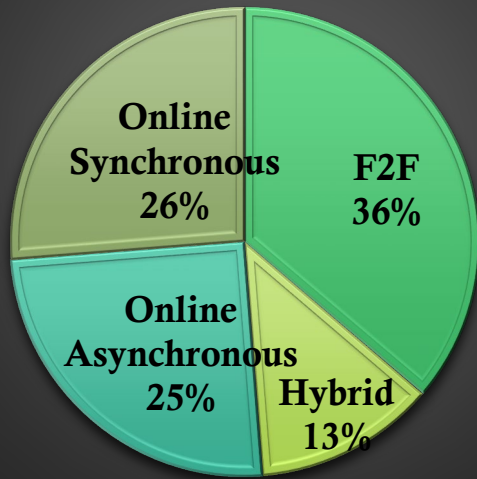
Canada College Fall 2022 Course Fill Rate by Modality



Cross-Listed Course Section, Enrollment, and Fill Rate by Modality

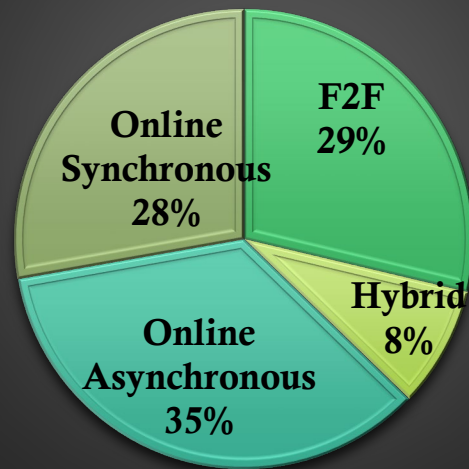

Cross-Listed Course Sections (N=80) by Modality



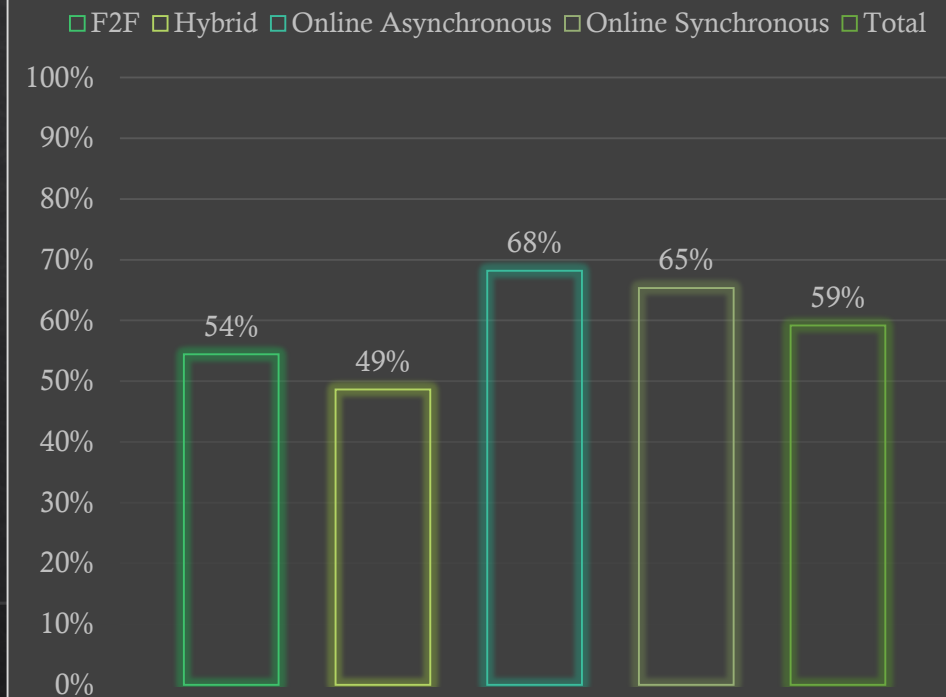

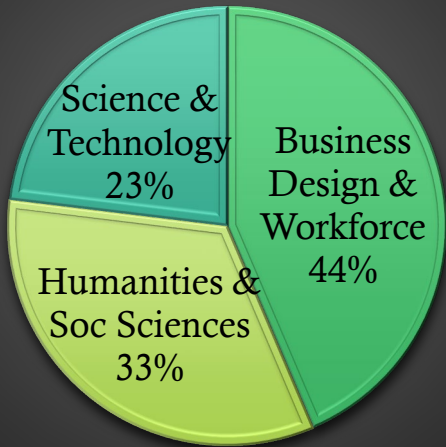

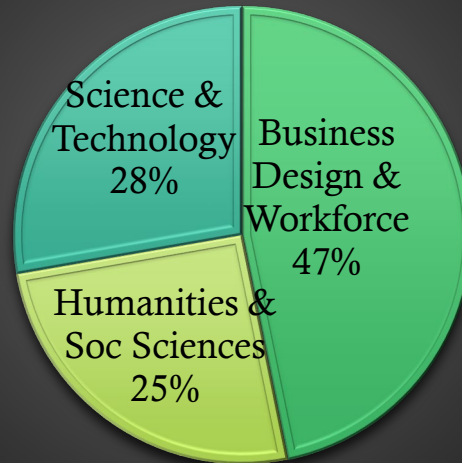

Multi-Modals Course Section (N=39)



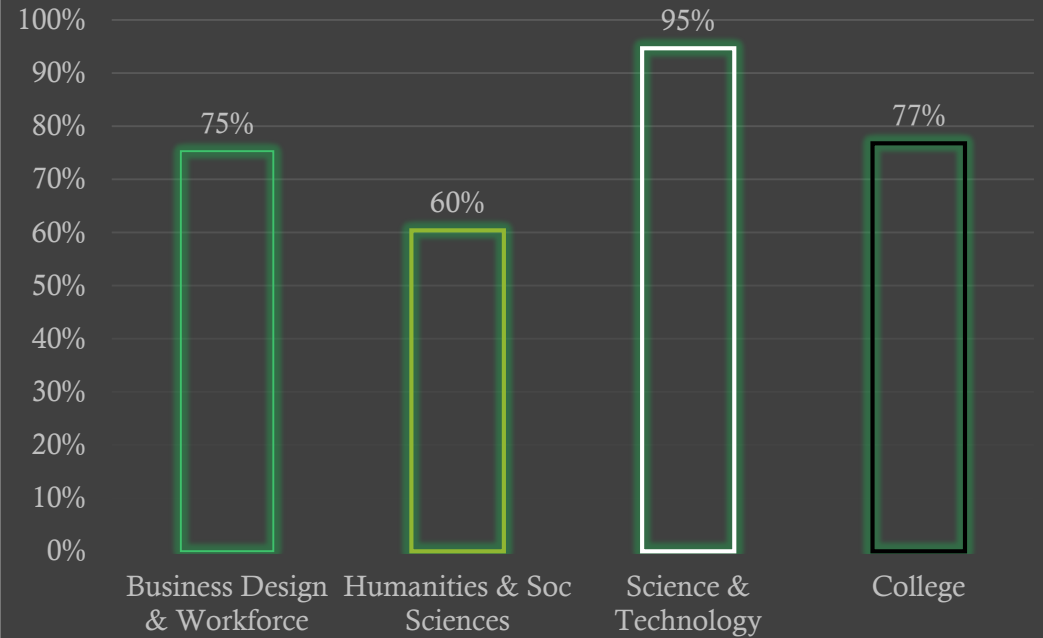

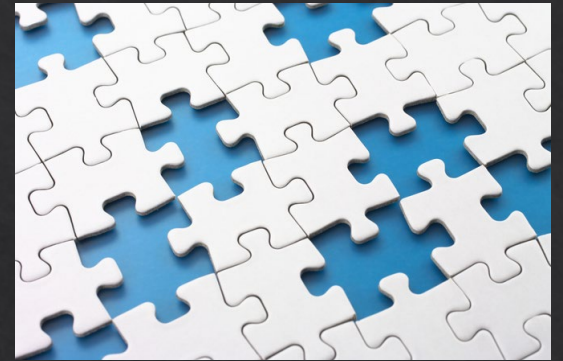
