*We acknowledge that Cañada College is situated on the traditional unceded land of the Ramaytush (Rah-my-toosh) Ohlone (OhLOW-nee) peoples, and we respect our past elders and honor the present community. *We have a responsibility to acknowledge that we as a Cañada community have benefited from the use and occupation of this land and that the tragic legacy of colonization, genocide, capitalism, racism, and oppression still impacts people today.*

*We also recognize the labor upon which this educational institution, state, and country is built. We acknowledge the peoples of African ancestry who were enslaved and forcibly brought to this land, and whose forced labor played a major role in the formation of this country. We are indebted to their uncompensated labor and their unwilling sacrifice over hundreds of years—which continues to impact generations today. We honor the legacy of the African diaspora and the continued contribution of their survivors.*

*We acknowledge the contributions of all immigrant labor, forced labor, and undocumented people who contributed, and continue to contribute, to the building and feeding of this land. We acknowledge their immeasurable sacrifices and work that allow us to gather in this space today.*

*Let us not forget. Let us honor and engage with the people who have stewarded and labored on this land for generations, and let us honor these truths—by taking responsibility as a college community to continually educate ourselves about these realities, to affirm our commitment to justice through continual action, and to protect and sustain this land.*

- Tennis Club - Requesting \$280

- Cañada College Car Club - Requesting \$100
  - Cañada College Cars & Coffee Event
  - November 24, 2024
  - The Club will front \$30-40
  - Coffee: \$40-50, Donuts: \$40-50, Cups, Lids, and Napkins: \$10-20
  - This car meet will be an inclusive event that brings students from diverse backgrounds together through a shared interest in cars. It will serve as an

- Christ Flow - Requesting \$480
  - November 25, 2024
  - Thanksgiving Potluck
  - We plan to have a Thanksgiving potluck on 11/25 for our club meeting. There will be games involved and the potluck part of the event will include people bringing different desserts. The funding request is meant to be for food catered...that is yet to be decided. Last year, we had a Thanksgiving potluck where the catering cost about \$550.00 which barely lasted for everyone. The extra \$50 to make \$600 is just in case for the catering and for the event overall.

  - The club will contribute: \$120.00 contributed to catering; but some members who might voluntarily contribute to personally bringing desserts for the potluck.
